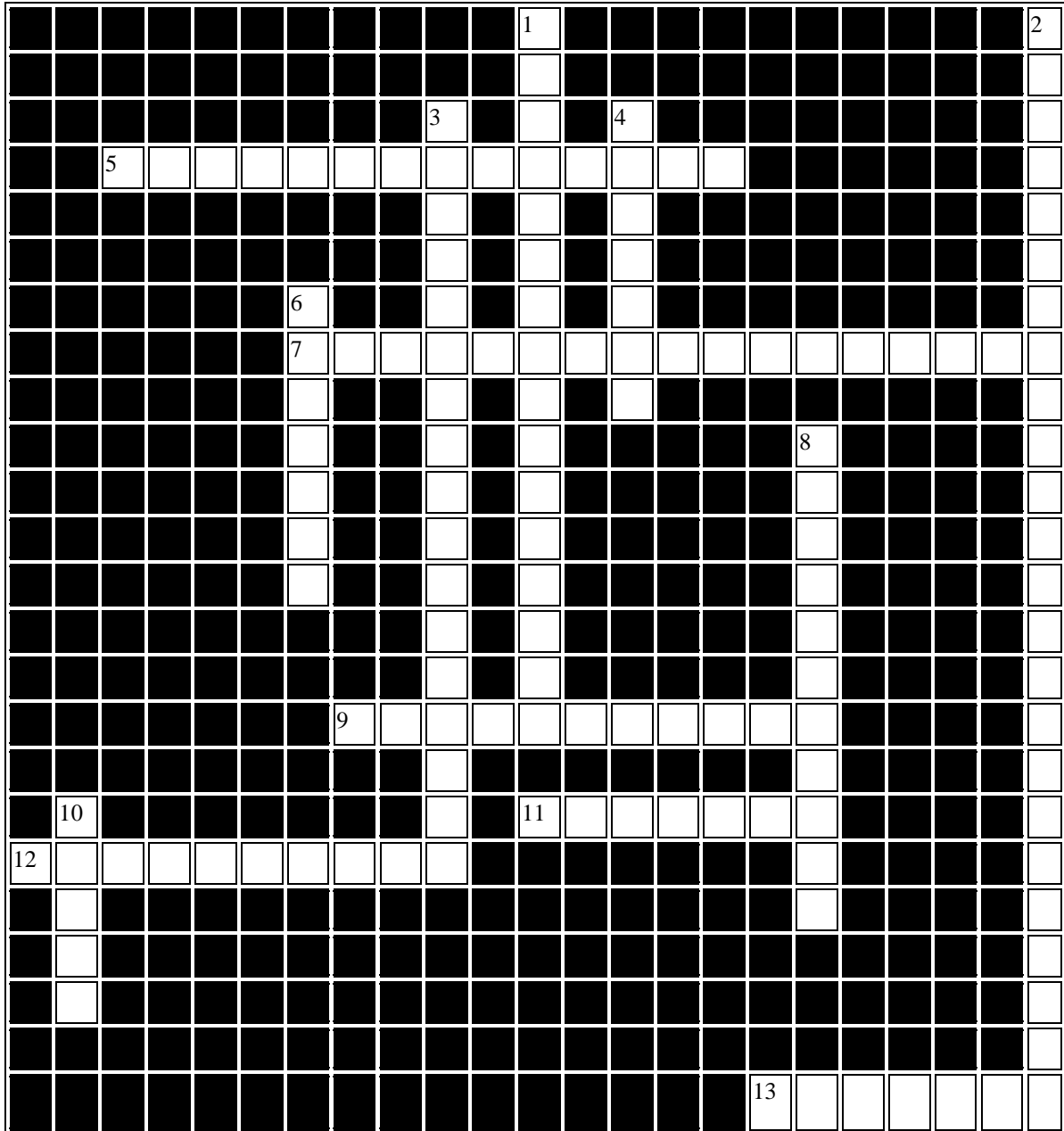


Clipper Heritage Trail
